CONFERENCE

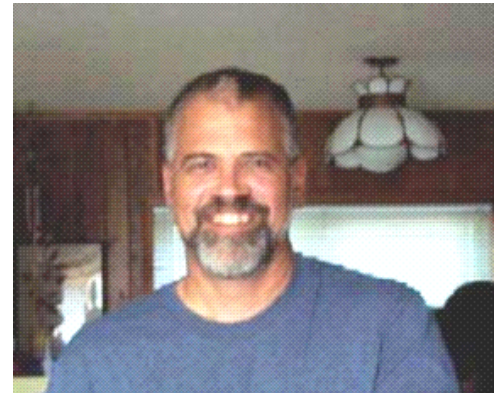

Enough about that.

Minutes: Sarah Smith read the Minutes for October 12th, 2008 and they were approved.

Treasurers Report: Don Harris gave the report. Motion to approve was made by Jim Robertson and seconded by Rick Presnell. Motion passed.

Ron Valleroy reported that Mike Nuyt raised a considerable amount of money selling tickets for a gun raffle. This information is for our organization only.
